Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

- implemented environmental management plans, actions and procedures on at least 2 occasions.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- technical terms, including environmental protection, risk, hazard, control, impact, assessment and management
- environmental management concepts, including conservation, cultural heritage and biodiversity
- legislative and regulatory processes, requirements and responsibilities relevant to environmental plans and procedures, including how to search for and access relevant acts, regulations, standards and guidelines
- environmental management plans and procedures and standard operating procedures (SOPs) relevant to job role
- site characteristics and environmental issues, risks and impacts
- specified control measures and environmental management actions relevant to work activities
- workplace procedures for:
 - work health safety (WHS) including using personal protective equipment (PPE), identifying and responding to hazards and assessing risks associated with work activities at sites
 - responding to complaints, cultural heritage finds and other environmental incidents
 - environmental reporting.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
