Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

- planned, completed, monitored and finalised at least 2 simple environmental project activities.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- environmental terms, concepts and principles relevant to assigned project activities
- workplace project planning, management and reporting requirements
- workplace and regulator sampling, monitoring and testing procedures that apply to assigned project activities
- workplace procedures for identifying, assessing and controlling hazards and risks associated with project activities
- hazards, health and safety requirements and safe work procedures for work role.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
