Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

• scoped, planned, executed, analysed and finalised at least 1 small scale, low risk, measurement-based environmental project (either individually, or as part of a team).

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- environmental and measurement terms, concepts and principles
- legislative, regulatory and workplace requirements that apply to assigned project activities
- workplace and regulator sampling, monitoring and testing procedures that apply to assigned project activities
- project management principles and tools for project planning and monitoring of timelines, expenditure and performance
- techniques for achieving effective communication, teamwork and cooperation
- techniques for troubleshooting, problem solving and conflict resolution
- workplace project planning, management and reporting requirements
- workplace procedures for identifying and assessing and controlling hazards and risks associated with project activities
- hazards, health and safety requirements and safe work procedures for work role.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies. The following conditions must be met for this unit:

- use of facilities, equipment and resources, including:
 - site or project history, background information
 - project management procedures, tools and software
 - physical resources required for work activities, including safety equipment
 - workplace procedures, work program, maps, site plans, site sampling plans and specified sampling and test methods, equipment manuals and safe work procedures.

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Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
