- types of muda that may be found in the process or work area being improved and options to reduce these
- practices and/or approaches that support sustained improvements
- possible causes of underperformance and approaches to addressing them
- work health and safety, quality and environmental issues that affect the team or work area
- underpinning values relevant to competitive systems and practices including:
  - respect for people
  - respect for process
  - transparency and culture of learning.

## Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies. The following conditions must be met for this unit:

- use of suitable facilities, equipment and resources
- modelling of industry operating conditions, including:
  - • functioning competitive systems and practices environment.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
