This unit applies to any organisation that is implementing total preventative and/or productive maintenance (TPM), reliability centred maintenance (RCM) or similar proactive maintenance strategies.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills
