Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to implement competitive systems and practices in an organisation (or that part of the organisation that does not undertake repetitive processes or mass produce products. Instead it responds to individual and unique customer orders such as one-off or small batch orders (e.g. example overhaul of equipment, jobbing manufacture, supply of customised/bespoke services or product).

This unit applies to managers, technical specialists or similar roles with responsibility to analyse existing processes, develop a virtual flow process and negotiate restructure of process and work organisation to allow the application (or improvement) of competitive systems and practices tools and techniques.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.
