- how to determine, increase and apply benefit/cost ratios
- regulatory requirements relevant to process and organisation.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies. The following conditions must be met for this unit:

- use of suitable facilities, equipment and resources
- modelling of industry operating conditions.
