Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- sources of data and required calculations
- types and sources of energy
- methods of analysing energy efficiency for different types of energy
- methods of converting energy values from one form to another
- alternative sources of energy
- principles of energy efficiency
- sustainability regulatory and legislative requirements
- energy trading schemes and procedures
- organisation and process needs for energy
- muda (waste) including: necessary and unnecessary

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
