Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

- critically examined and mapped relationships within and between downstream, upstream and support teams for at least 1 organisation
- identified sources of conflict, tensions and competitions and developed, implemented and monitored at least 1 consensus solution.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- competitive systems and practices principles, strategies and techniques
- organisational goals, products and processes
- types of KPIs, their applications and limits
- approval processes within organisation
- communication methods across a variety of media and formats, including preparation of formal proposals and negotiations
- continuous improvement
- process mapping, communication and people interaction mapping
- customer perception of value.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
