Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to source ideas for design, prepare design concepts based on a design brief and communicate the design. Concepts are for simple textile products without complicated design features. Products may be apparel or non-wearable items.

The unit applies to individuals following the design process and the elements and principles of design to guide work.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills
