Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to finish and check completed textile products as part of the production process. Products may be apparel or non-wearable items. Work may be completed by hand or machine.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills

This section describes those language, literacy, numeracy and employment skills that are essential to performance but not explicit in the performance criteria.

- Writing skills to communicate simple factual information in familiar workplace documents
- Numeracy skills to interpret numerical information in specifications and take accurate measurements to support finishing tasks
