Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to prepare and attach simple headwear trims. It applies to multiple units of repetitive styles, such as sports caps, sun protective headwear, soft hats and adventure wear, sewn from textile products.

This unit applies to individuals working in accordance with pre-determined specifications and established procedures.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills
