Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and demonstrated the ability to:

- embellish textile products to specifications and workplace quality standards using at least three of the following methods on at least two different products in any combination:
 - appliqué
 - beading
 - embroidery stitches
 - fabric insertion
 - patchwork
 - pintucking
 - quilting
 - shirring
 - smocking.
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Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- key aspects of textile product embellishment:
 - types of equipment used for manual and machine embellishments and associated safety considerations
 - characteristics of fibres, threads, fabrics and other materials used
 - visual and performance criteria for selection of threads
 - factors for consideration when adding embellishments, including fabric, positioning and purpose of article
 - quality indicators for completed embellishments
 - ways of minimising waste

- types of information included in production documentation.
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Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies. The following conditions must be met for this unit:

- use of suitable facilities, equipment and resources, including:
 - work specifications
 - products for embellishing
 - tools, equipment and materials for embellishing
 - workplace procedures.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
