Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to develop specifications which provide detailed information for the production of a garment design. Specification documentation includes all information required to produce the garment, including drawings and other technical information about size specifications, materials, colour and construction detail. Information may vary depending on whether production is onshore or offshore.

This unit applies to individuals working in patternmaking or design roles.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.
