This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to construct blocks to meet size and fit specifications in garment production. Blocks are used as the basis for patternmaking to develop new styles.

Foundation Skills

- Numeracy skills to interpret and use blockmaking formulas and work with measurement concepts.
