Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to grade flat or 2D patterns used for production of garments with basic style features. The grading process may be manual or digital.

This unit applies to individuals working in situations where discretion and judgement may be required in planning and selecting processes, procedures or outcomes.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills

This section describes those language, literacy, numeracy and employment skills that are essential to performance but not explicit in the performance criteria.

- Reading skills to interpret detailed patternmaking information
- Writing skills to communicate factual pattern and production information in workplace documents
- Numeracy skills to interpret numerical aspects of design specifications, take accurate measurements and make simple calculations.

Other foundation skills essential to performance are explicit in the performance criteria of this unit.
