Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to create a garment pattern from an existing block for an individual size. It includes measuring the client and determining pattern modifications needed to achieve optimum individual fit.

This unit applies to individuals who use discretion and judgement in planning and selecting patternmaking processes to achieve outcomes.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills

This section describes those language, literacy, numeracy and employment skills that are essential to performance but not explicit in the performance criteria.

- Reading skills to interpret pattern information
- Writing skills to communicate factual pattern and production information in workplace documents
- Oral communication skills to interact respectfully with client when taking measurements
- Numeracy skills to interpret numerical aspects of design specifications, take accurate measurements and make simple calculations.

Other foundation skills essential to performance are explicit in the performance criteria of this unit.
