Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to use draping techniques to create a basic fitted foundation. This applies to the creation of fitted blocks for tops and skirts and does not include draping of set-in sleeves. Draping is conducted on a body form, such as a mannequin or model.

This unit of competency applies to patternmakers.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills

This section describes those language, literacy, numeracy and employment skills that are essential to performance but not explicit in the performance criteria.

- Reading skills to interpret design specifications
- Writing skills to communicate factual pattern and production information in workplace documents
- Numeracy skills to interpret numerical aspects of design specifications, take accurate measurements and make simple calculations.
