Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to select or modify a pattern and perform cutting of one-off single lays to meet design requirements and individual client needs. It includes assessing body characteristics, taking body measurements and interpreting those measurements to inform cutting requirements. The degree of complexity may vary depending on characteristics of the fabrics being used and intricacy of design. Measuring and laying up tasks may be associated with operations where size, shape and cost of fabric are significant.

This unit applies to individuals who use discretion and judgement in planning and selecting patternmaking and garment production processes to achieve outcomes.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills

- Oral communication skills to interact with client using effective verbal and non-verbal communication techniques
