## MSTAT4014 Assemble and fit bespoke garments

### Modification History

### Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to plan and select processes, procedures and outcomes in response to a tailored or bespoke garment brief where fabric pieces have already been cut. It includes pinning and sewing of fabric pieces, initial assembly, sewing whole garment, and fitting and modifying the garment as required to meet client requirements. It also involves hand sewing, completing trims and undertaking alterations as required to confirm correct sizing, look and wearer comfort.

This unit applies to individuals who use discretion and judgement in planning and selecting processes to achieve outcomes.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

## Foundation Skills
