Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to develop designs and produce knitted textile products to meet a specified design brief. It applies to knitted products such as garments, furnishing items, accessories or fabrics. Note that this unit does not address fully fashioned knitted products.

This unit applies to textile designers.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.
