Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to construct blocks to develop patterns for garments that require advanced styling such as structured tailoring, evening wear, bridal wear, corsetry, complex or experimental drape, complex patternmaking or significant detailing.

This unit applies to patternmakers who work in accordance with existing specifications using discretion, judgement and problem solving to achieve work outcomes.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills

This section describes those language, literacy, numeracy and employment skills that are essential to performance but not explicit in the performance criteria.

- Writing skills to communicate factual pattern and production information in workplace documents
- Numeracy skills to interpret and use blockmaking formulas and work with measurement concepts.
