Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to analyse the fit of a garment or toile on the individual body, make necessary adjustments and alter the pattern.

This unit applies to individuals who use discretion and judgement in planning and selecting patternmaking processes to achieve outcomes.

Foundation Skills

This section describes those language, literacy, numeracy and employment skills that are essential to performance but not explicit in the performance criteria.

- Writing skills to communicate factual pattern and production information in workplace documents
- Oral communication skills to interact respectfully with client when taking measurements
- Numeracy skills to take accurate measurements and make simple calculations.
