Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to use digital technologies to produce patterns and complete pattern grading for garments. It involves the use of specialised electronic programs and computing equipment to digitise patterns and access existing pattern block libraries to create and grade pattern styles for a set size range.

This unit applies to patternmakers who work in accordance with existing specifications using discretion, judgement and problem solving to maximise cost efficiency and quality.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.
