Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to perform contour draping for styled garments that are worn against the body. Draping may be for a one-off garment that goes from drape to garment or a prototype that goes from drape to flat pattern for small volume production. Draping is performed on a body form, such as a mannequin or model.

This unit applies to individuals who work in accordance with design specifications.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

3. Perform drape	 3.1 Pin fabric on body form and perform draping operations to meet design requirements 3.2 Remove drape from model 3.3 Finalise drape and direct to next production process
