Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to create, implement, and document a specification and process plan for products with advanced design details. This is achieved through a process of sample production and evaluation.

This unit applies to designers and more senior production personnel who use knowledge of design and production processes to select and adapt approaches to work to achieve desired outcomes.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.
