Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to check machine performance and complete minor adjustments and maintenance on production machines.

This unit applies to individuals working in accordance with established procedures on routine and minor maintenance tasks. The individual may also be the machine operator. This unit does not apply to machine mechanics who undertake more significant machine repair and maintenance.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Work involves limited discretion, initiative and judgement on the job in own work, including liaison with specialist mechanics and technicians.

Maintain effective machine operation	3.1 Clean machine in accordance with manufacturer cleaning instructions and work schedules 3.2 Complete routine maintenance tasks in accordance with manufacturer instructions and record in accordance with workplace procedures 3.3 Check machine to ensure correct operation after maintenance activities

Foundation Skills

This section describes those language, literacy, numeracy and employment skills that are essential to performance but not explicit in the performance criteria.

- Reading skills to interpret familiar workplace procedures and basic aspects of unfamiliar manufacturer instruction/technical specification manuals
- Writing skills to communicate simple factual information in familiar workplace documents
- Numeracy skills to interpret numerical information in manuals and adjust settings on machinery.

Other foundation skills essential to performance are explicit in the performance criteria of this unit.
