Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to manage technical processes, particularly in preparing chemicals, monitoring production stages and measuring specified process parameters for products such as hide, skin and leather, fibres, yarns or fabrics.

This unit applies to individuals who use judgement to plan and select appropriate processes or procedures for self and others.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills
