Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to establish business requirements and supply criteria, and then to assess and compare different suppliers and place orders for textile materials and resources.

This unit applies to individuals who analyse and compare information from a range of different sources to determine optimum supply arrangements. They do this within established business objectives and frameworks.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.
