This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to research and evaluate processes and products to inform business opportunities in a textiles, clothing and footwear (TCF) organisation. It includes the requirement to establish and analyse the opportunities, constraints and business implications of local and global trends, and to contribute to strategic planning to progress identified opportunities. Trends includes those related to design, technology, market forces, regulations, supply chain, sustainability and circularity.

This unit applies to individuals working in senior design and production roles.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.
