Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to cut prescribed lengths of metal bar stock and to bend the lengths into various shapes by hand or with the aid of formers.

This unit applies to individuals working in accordance with pre-determined specifications and established procedures.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Maintain work area and equipment	4.1 Label or tag completed product and complete documentation in accordance with workplace procedures 4.2 Clean work area and store tools and electrical equipment in accordance with workplace procedures 4.3 Follow workplace procedures for reuse, recycling and disposal of materials 4.4 Clean tools and equipment and complete routine operator maintenance in accordance with workplace procedures and manufacturer instructions
