Foundation Skills

This section describes those language, literacy, numeracy and employment skills that are essential to performance but not explicit in the performance criteria.

- Reading skills to interpret familiar workplace documentation and unfamiliar adhesive product instructions
- Writing skills to communicate factual information in familiar workplace documents
- Numeracy skills to interpret and use information associated with area and ratios for measuring amounts of adhesive to be used.
