Thoroughbred

Workplace Trainer Thoroughbred Racing

- Self Paced learning packages for Category 1 workplace trainers. Designed for thoroughbred trainers with trainees or apprentices.

- Can be teacher delivered - current indications are that it is best to offer this package with teacher assistance.
- Preparation, delivery and assessment of workplace based training.

Workplace Assessor Thoroughbred Racing

- Principles of workplace based assessment.
- Details on job assessment requirements - RPL manuals can be used to accompany this package.
- Targeted for Thoroughbred trainers with trainees or apprentices.
- Details recording requirements for workplace training & assessment.

Trainee Resource Booklets

- Trainee resource booklets have been developed for each module within the national curriculum.
- These materials contain relevant information required of each module and a variety of exercises for trainees to complete both on and off the job.
- These booklets are designed to assist training and to accompany both on and off job training.
- They are not stand alone self paced learning packages.
- Individual state variations to the materials are required to be made by training providers. This information relates to such matters as local rules of racing, and some terminology.
- There is a wide variety of language and literacy skills amongst trainees. The booklets have been prepared taking this into account. It should be noted that no national booklet will accommodate the wide literacy requirements of this client group. It may be necessary to write some of the material "up" or "down" depending upon individual trainee needs.

Trainee Record Books

- A trainee record book has been developed which allows for recording completion of learning outcomes on or off the job or by the RPL process.

- This booklet contains both on and off job learning outcomes.
- This booklet records information for each trainee against each learning outcome. RPL challenge tests and assessment support materials provide an excellent basis for assessment techniques of trainees and should be used in conjunction with the trainee record book.
