Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the NWP National Water Training Package.

Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to inspect and report on embankment dam safety.

It includes preparing for and implementing dam safety visual inspections, reporting on conditions, faults in embankment dams and appurtenant structures. It also includes initiating emergency plans.

This unit applies to those with responsibility for the inspection of embankment dams and reporting of faults or trends. Those undertaking this unit would work under appropriate supervision while performing routine tasks in range of familiar contexts.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.
