Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the NWP National Water Training Package.

Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to disinfect network assets.

It includes planning and preparing the worksite and performing volumetric calculations, when additional disinfection is required.

This unit applies to those working as field and operational staff with responsibility for the operation and maintenance of chemical dosing equipment. Those undertaking this unit would work independently, under appropriate supervision, while performing routine tasks with a moderate level of complexity in a familiar context.
