Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the NWP National Water Training Package.

Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to clean networks using air scouring, chemical or swabbing techniques.

It includes planning and preparing the worksite and conducting and completing cleaning activities.

This unit applies to those using swabs or air scouring to undergo cleaning of network pipes. Those undertaking this unit would work independently under indirect supervision while performing routine tasks with a moderate level of complexity in familiar contexts.

The skills and knowledge described in this unit must be applied within the legislative, regulatory and policy environment in which they are carried out. Workplace policies and procedures must be consulted and adhered to.
