Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the NWP National Water Training Package.

Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to monitor trade waste approvals.

It includes coordinating, implementing and reporting on monitoring programs for trade waste treatment and disposal in retail commercial and light industrial organisations. It also applies to the monitoring of complex trade waste systems in large organisations.

This unit applies to those working with a specific responsibility for coordinating and conducting monitoring and testing of trade waste treatment and disposal. Those undertaking this unit would work autonomously, usually with supervisory responsibilities, while performing complex tasks in a range of contexts.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.
