Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the NWP National Water Training Package.

Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to monitor and operate fluoride addition processes.

It includes preparing for fluoridation processes, applying fluoride dosing and reporting on water quality control.

This unit applies to those working as water operators responsible for fluoridation processes in water treatment. Those undertaking this unit would work under appropriate supervision, while performing routine tasks, in a range of familiar contexts.
