Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the NWP National Water Training Package.

Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to operate and control membrane filters.

It includes monitoring membrane filtration plant, microfiltration, ultrafiltration and nanofiltration, measuring and reporting on system performance and processing quality control. It also includes identifying faults, determining and applying adjustments and conducting chemical procedures.

This unit applies to operational staff members with a specific responsibility for membrane filtration processes in treatment plants. Those undertaking this unit would work under appropriate supervision, while performing routine tasks, within a familiar context.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.
