Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the NWP National Water Training Package.

Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to operate and control solids handling processes.

It includes monitoring water, wastewater dewatering, sludge thickening plant and measuring and reporting on system performance and process quality control. It also includes identifying faults, determining and applying technical adjustments and conducting chemical dosing procedures.

This unit applies to operational staff with a specific responsibility for water or wastewater dewatering and sludge thickening processes in a treatment plant. Those undertaking this unit would work under appropriate supervision, while performing routine tasks within a familiar context.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.
