Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the NWP National Water Training Package.

Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to operate and control incineration processes.

It includes monitoring an incineration plant, measuring and reporting on system performance and process quality control. It also includes identifying faults and determining and applying technical adjustments essential to performance.

This unit applies to operational staff with a specific responsibility for incineration processes in water treatment plants. Those undertaking this unit would work under appropriate supervision, while performing routine tasks, within familiar contexts.
