Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and demonstrated the ability to:

- hand decorate products at least once to meet job specifications.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- product quality requirements
- product defect classifications
- types and application of common hand decorating techniques
- product decoration and reworking methods, workflow sequences and materials for common product requirements
- equipment typically used in hand decoration of products, and criteria for suitability of selection
- inspection methods for identifying presence of surface defects or contaminants
- key variables that affect the viability of applying hand decoration, and variables during hand decoration
- sources of contamination that may affect hand decoration and how to eliminate them
- typical quality standards required in original products and as the result of hand decoration
- typical and atypical product defects and production problems, including early warning signs, possible causes and corrective actions
- the distinguishing characteristics of possible causes of routine faults, including:
 - raw material variations
 - contamination of raw materials
 - process/procedural problems
 - mechanical abnormalities
- organisational procedures relevant to the work environment or job role
- hazards that may arise in the job or work environment, and:
 - their possible causes
 - potential consequences
 - appropriate risk controls.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
