# Assessment Requirements for PMBPROD206E Operate ancillary equipment

## Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and demonstrated the ability to:

- operate ancillary equipment at least once to meet production requirements.

## Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- the function and operating principles of ancillary equipment and components
- main and ancillary production workflow sequences and materials demand
- the criteria for overall process/equipment readiness for the process and equipment being used
- key variables that may affect equipment function and resulting production output on main production line
- typical process and equipment problems, including early warning signs, possible causes and corrective actions
- organisational procedures relevant to the work environment and job role, including procedures for the emergency shutdown of equipment
- hazards that may arise in the job or work environment, and:
  - their possible causes
  - potential consequences
  - appropriate risk controls.

## Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
