Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- the function of extrusion equipment machine components and ancillary equipment
- principles of operation of single-screw and twin-screw extruders
- · extrusion production workflow sequences and materials demand
- key variables that may impact product quality and production output
- typical quality standards at each stage of production
- typical process and product problems, including early warning signs, possible causes and corrective actions
- organisational procedures relevant to the work environment or job role, including procedures for the emergency shutdown of equipment
- hazards that may arise in the job or work environment, and:
 - their possible causes
 - potential consequences
 - appropriate risk controls.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
