Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to plan and construct moulds from which composite products can be made.

This unit applies to an experienced technician working alone or as part of a team.

The unit principally refers to the materials performance science of thick laminates with suitable structural support, and its application to produce a mould suitable for production processes.

No licensing or certification requirements exist at the time of publication. Relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills
