Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and demonstrated the ability to:

• construct jigs and fixtures to meet job specifications.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- manufacturing process and product characteristics that determine jig and fixture construction and operational parameters
- · production workflow sequences and materials demand
- typical quality standards required at each stage of production
- key variables that may affect product quality and production output, and possible options for adjustments including introduction of automated extras
- typical and atypical process and product problems, including early warning signs, possible causes and corrective actions
- organisational procedures relevant to the work environment or job role
- hazards that may arise in the job or work environment, and:
 - their possible causes
 - potential consequences
 - appropriate risk controls.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
