Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to administer legislation in a policing environment, including the application of legislation and powers and the production of judicial documentation.

This unit applies to those working as community police officer, in metropolitan and/or remote areas.

The skills and knowledge described in this unit must be applied within the legislative, regulatory and policy environment in which they are carried out. Organisational policies and procedures must be consulted and adhered to.

Those undertaking this unit would demonstrate independent judgement. They would perform routine tasks, whilst providing and communicating solutions to problems in a range of known contexts.
