Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to promote public order through policing services, including patrols, initial response and preservation of scenes and evidence.

This unit applies to those working as community police officer, in metropolitan and/or remote areas.

The skills and knowledge described in this unit must be applied within the legislative, regulatory and policy environment in which they are carried out. Organisational policies and procedures must be consulted and adhered to.

Those undertaking this unit would demonstrate independent judgement and take responsibility in known contexts and defined parameters. They would perform routine tasks, while providing and communicating solutions to problems in a range of contexts.
