Performance Evidence

The candidate must provide evidence on at least one occasion that they have met the elements and performance criteria and have demonstrated the ability to:

- communicate care or custody information verbally and in writing
- complete handover requirements for persons in care or custody
- document the services provided to persons in care or custody
- identify referral requirements
- identify safety risks to self, colleagues and public
- identify services and resources, both internal and external, required to manage persons in care or custody
- monitor, manage and review the supervision provided to persons in care or custody.

Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must provide demonstrated evidence that they have knowledge of:

- capabilities, powers and authorities of services external to policing
- duty of care responsibilities and custodial practices
- jurisdictional legislation, policies and procedures relating to care or custody management
- jurisdictional policies and procedures relating to work health and safety
- jurisdictional policies and procedures relating to mental health and wellbeing
- jurisdictional codes of conduct
- communication techniques relevant to care or custody situations.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must occur in operational workplace situations or, where this is not available, in simulated situations that replicate workplace conditions. Assessors of this unit must satisfy relevant vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
