## Performance Evidence

The candidate must provide evidence on at least one occasion that they have met the elements and performance criteria and have demonstrated the ability to:

- assess road policing scenarios to identify traffic offences
- assess road situations to identify safety issues
- conduct vehicle stops and pullovers
- demonstrate an understanding of safe police pursuit practices
- direct and manage traffic flow
- identify legislation relevant to road policing
- prepare and drive police vehicles to deliver policing responses
- use appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).

## Knowledge Evidence

The candidate must provide demonstrated evidence that they have knowledge of:

- jurisdictional policies and procedures related to road policing, including police pursuits
- jurisdictional road safety strategies
- road policing equipment
- road rules
- road safety legislation and regulations
- work health and safety (WHS) / occupational health and safety (OHS) legislation.

## Assessment Conditions

Assessment must occur in operational workplace situations or, where this is not available, in simulated situations that replicate workplace conditions. Assessors of this unit must satisfy relevant vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
